I like to do that.

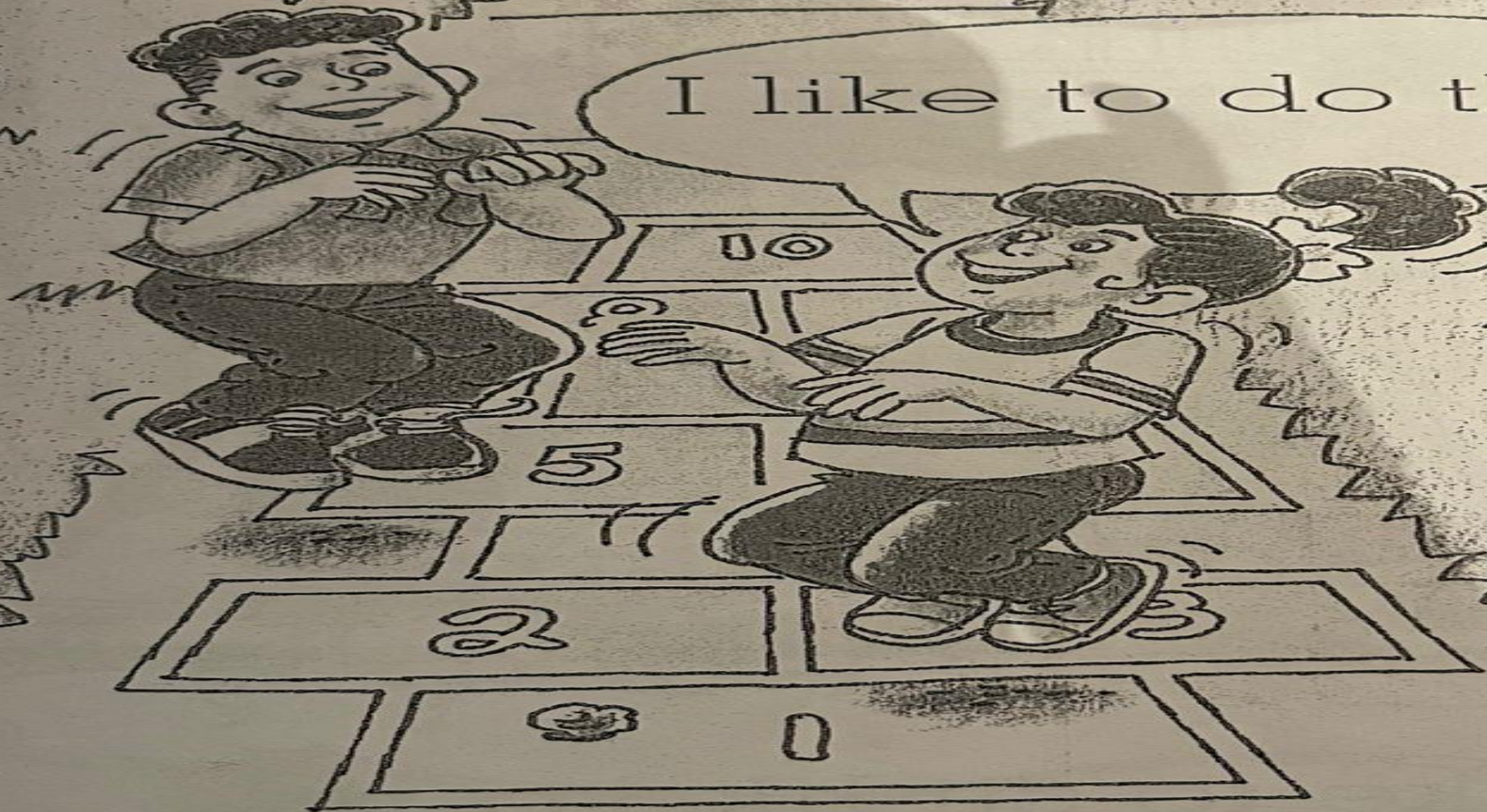





I like to hop like a  rabbit.

Phonics for Families: This book provides practice reading words that begin with *h, d, k*; words that end with *-ot* and *-op*; and the high-frequency words *not, you, do, like, to, and that*. Encourage your child to read the book aloud. Then have your child name words that rhyme with *hop* and *not*. You may also want to have your child tell what he or she likes to do.

Phonics Skills: Initial consonants *h, d, k*; Word families *-ot, -op*

High-Frequency Words: *not, you, do, like, to, that*

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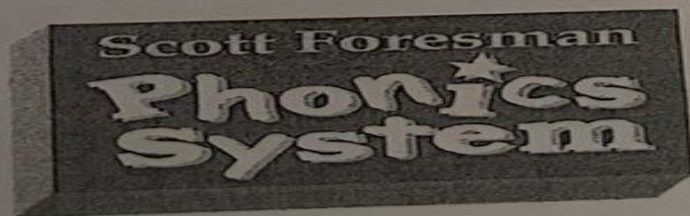
