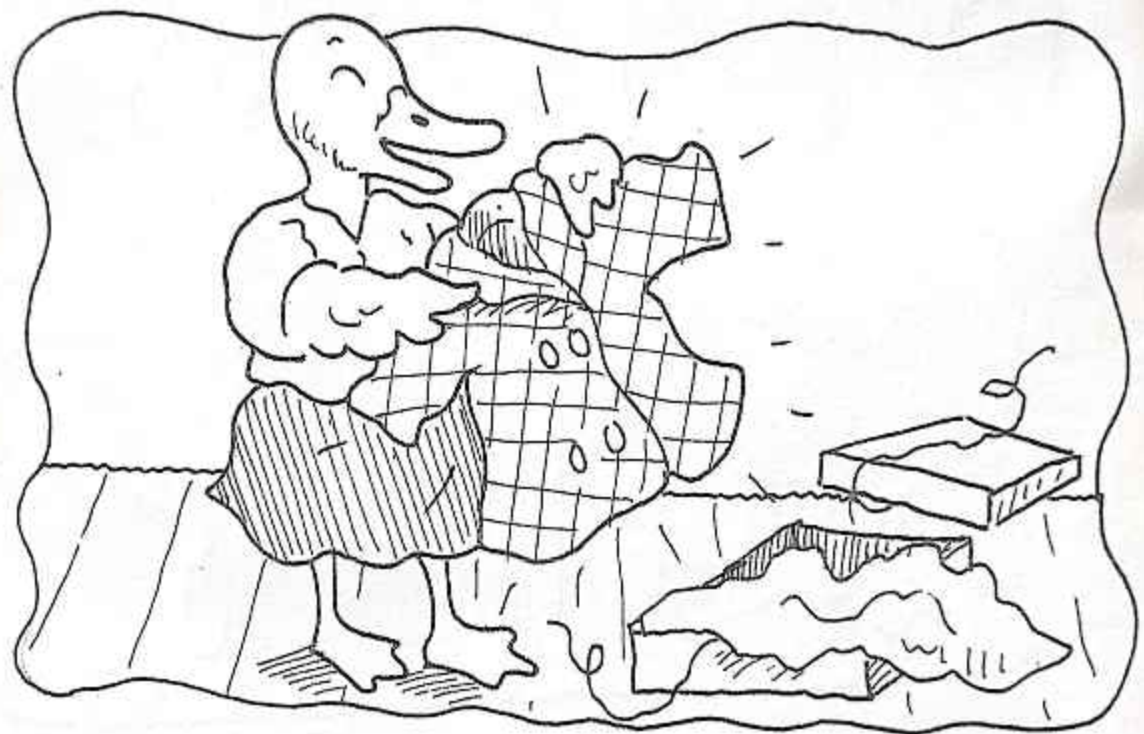
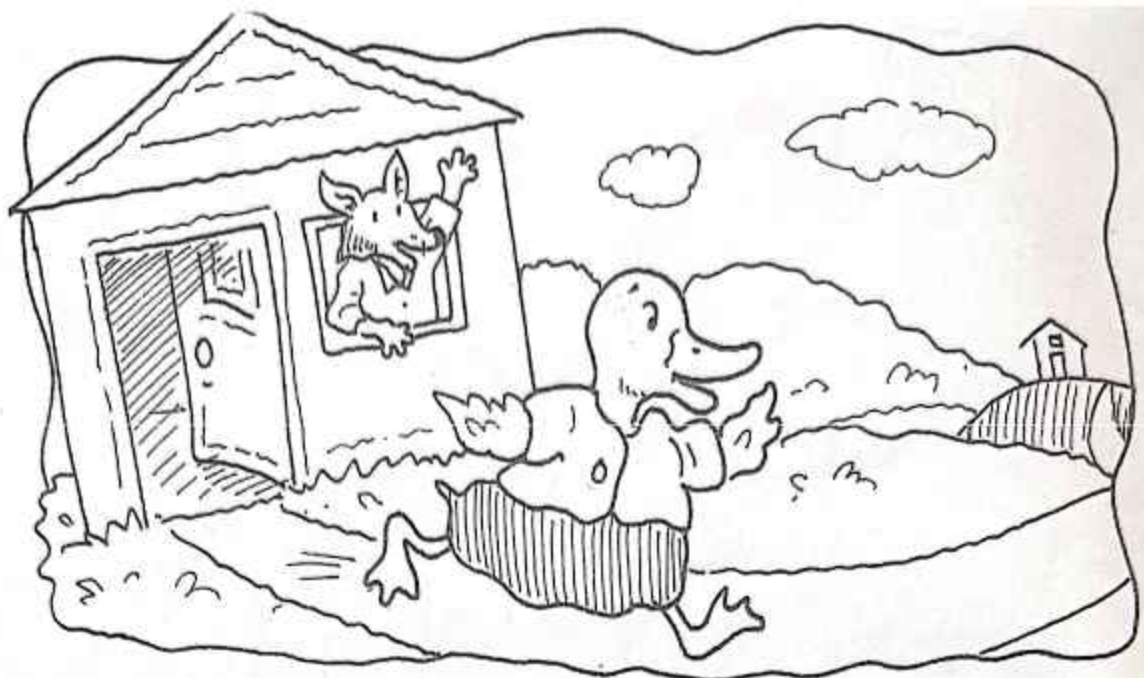


At last she asked Fox.
