
Astronomer: A scientist who studies stars, planets, and space.



Space probe: A machine sent into space to explore planets and collect information.




Core: The very center part of a planet, like Earth's hot, molten center.



Gravity: A force that pulls objects toward each other, like how Earth pulls us down.




Orbit: The curved path a planet or moon follows around a star or planet.




Matter: Anything that takes up space and has weight; everything around us is made of matter.
