We put have or has at the beginning of a question to ask if a person has got something. We can give short answers with Yes or No, the person, and have/has or haven't/hasn't without the word got.

Have I got ...? Yes, I/you have. / No, I/you haven't. (s) Have you got ...? Yes, I have. / No, I haven't. Has he got ...? Yes, he has. / No, he hasn't. Has she got ...? Yes, she has. / No, she hasn't. Has it got ...? Yes, it has. / No, it hasn't. Yes, we have. / No, we haven't. Have we got ...? Yes, we have. / No, we haven't. (p)Have you got ...? Yes, they have. / No, they haven't. Have they got ...?

Has Nancy got maths on Monday?
Yes, she has. / No, she hasn't.
Have you got English on Wednesday?
Yes, we have. / No, we haven't.

♣ We use have got to say that a thing belongs to a person, or to describe a person or a thing. When we speak, we usually use the short form.

I have got I've got

you have got you've got

he has got he's got

she has got she's got

it has got it's got

we have got we've got

you have got you've got

they have got they've got

I've got science on Saturday.

Mary's got PE on Friday and computers on Thursday.
