✚ We put **have** or **has** at the beginning of a question to ask if a person has got something. We can give short answers with **Yes** or **No**, the person, and **have/has** or **haven't/hasn't** without the word **got**.

Have I **got** ...?

Yes, I/you **have**. / No, I/you **haven't**.

(s) **Have** you **got** ...?

Yes, I **have**. / No, I **haven't**.

Has he **got** ...?

Yes, he **has**. / No, he **hasn't**.

Has she **got** ...?

Yes, she **has**. / No, she **hasn't**.

Has it **got** ...?

Yes, it **has**. / No, it **hasn't**.

Have we **got** ...?

Yes, we **have**. / No, we **haven't**.

(p) **Have** you **got** ...?

Yes, we **have**. / No, we **haven't**.

Have they **got** ...?

Yes, they **have**. / No, they **haven't**.

Has Nancy **got** maths on Monday?

Yes, she **has**. / **No**, she **hasn't**.

Have you **got** English on Wednesday?

Yes, we **have**. / **No**, we **haven't**.



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✚ We use **have got** to say that a thing belongs to a person, or to describe a person or a thing. When we speak, we usually use the short form.

you **have got**

you've got

he **has got**

he's got

she **has got**

she's got

it **has got**

it's got

we **have got**

we've got

you **have got**

you've got

they **have got**

they've got

I've got science on Saturday.

Mary's got PE on Friday and computers on Thursday.
