Words with More Than One Meaning

- pupil (noun)

A student in school.

The black part in the center of your eye.

- club (noun)

A group of people who meet for a shared interest (e.g., a sports club).

A heavy stick used as a weapon or for sports.

- bank (noun)

A place where people keep or borrow money.

The side of a river.

- bat (noun)

A small animal that flies at night.

A stick used to hit a ball in games like baseball or cricket.

- ring (noun)

A piece of jewelry worn on your finger.

The sound of a bell or phone.

- mean (adjective / verb)

(adjective) Unkind or not nice.

(verb) To express or show something ('What do you mean?').

- watch (noun / verb)

(noun) A small clock you wear on your wrist.

(verb) To look at something carefully.

- minute (noun / adjective)

(noun) 60 seconds of time.

(adjective) Very small.

- entrance (noun / verb)

(noun) A way into a place (door or gate).

(verb) To fill someone with wonder or delight.

- content (noun / adjective)

(noun) What something contains (like the content of a book).

(adjective) Happy or satisfied.

- present (noun / verb)

(noun) A gift.

(verb) To give something or show it to others.
