## Homophones (same sound, different meaning/spelling):

Pair/Pear

To/Too/Two

Sea/See

## Homographs (same spelling, different meaning):

Bat (Animal/Sports Equipment)

Tear (Cry/Rip)

Lead (Metal/Guide)

# Homophones (Same sound, different meaning/spelling → Students use both in sentences)

#### 1. Two / To / Too

I have two pens. I'm going to school. I like ice cream too.

#### 2. See / Sea

I see a bird. We swam in the sea.

#### 3. Pair / Pear

I bought a pair of shoes. I ate a juicy pear.

## 4. Flower / Flour

The flower is red. We need flour to bake bread.

## 5. Right / Write

Turn right at the corner. I like to write stories.

## 6. Bare / Bear

He walked with bare feet. A bear lives in the forest.

## 7. Break / Brake

Don't break the glass. Press the brake to stop the car.

## 8. Hole / Whole

There is a hole in my sock. I ate the whole pizza.

## 9. Dear / Deer

My dear friend is kind. We saw a deer in the woods.

## **10. Know / No**

I know the answer. No, I don't want to go.

## Homographs (Same spelling, different meaning → Students explain both)

#### 1. Bat

A bat flew out of the cave. He hit the ball with a bat.

#### 2. Tear

A tear rolled down her cheek. Please don't tear the paper.

#### 3. Lead

The pipes are made of lead. She will lead the group.

#### 4. Row

They had a row (argument). We sat in the front row.

#### 5. Wind

The wind is strong today. Wind the clock every night.

#### 6. Close

Please close the window. The shop is close to my house.

#### 7. Well

I am feeling well. They dug a well for water.

#### 8. Fair

The judge was fair. We went to the school fair.

#### 9. Park

We went to the park. Please park the car here.

#### 10. Light

Turn on the light. This bag is very light to carry.
