6. **distracted (adj)** : confused because you are thinking of sth else
➤ distract (v), distraction (n)
7. **delayed (adj)** : happening later than expected
➤ delay (v) 📎 Opp: punctual, on time
8. **unpredictable (adj)** : likely to change unexpectedly
➤ predict (v), prediction (n) 📎 Opp: predictable
9. **misophonia (n)** : a medical condition in which certain sounds cause a strong negative reaction
10. **reliable (adj)** : that can be trusted
➤ rely (v), reliability (n) 📎 Opp: unreliable
11. **correspond (v)** : match; be similar or equal to
➤ correspondence (n)
12. **embarrassment (n)** : a feeling of shame and/or shyness
➤ embarrass (v), embarrassing (adj), embarrassed (adj)
13. **frustration (n)**: the state of feeling bad because you cannot achieve what you want
➤ frustrated (adj), frustrating (adj)

14. **sympathy (n)** : the understanding that you show when sb else is suffering
➤ sympathise (v), sympathetic (adj)
15. **despair (n)** : the feeling that there is no hope and nothing will get better
➤ despair (v), desperate (adj), desperately (adv)
