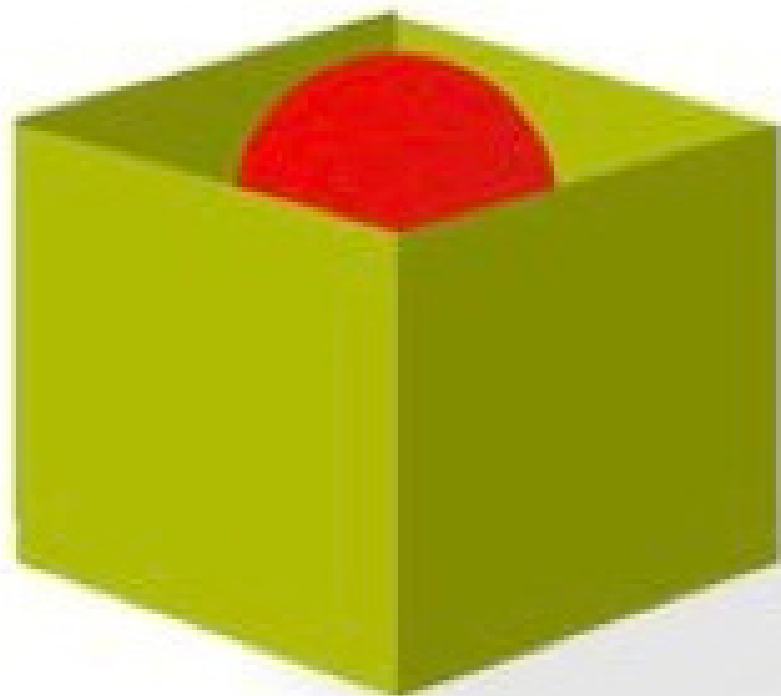

someone is.

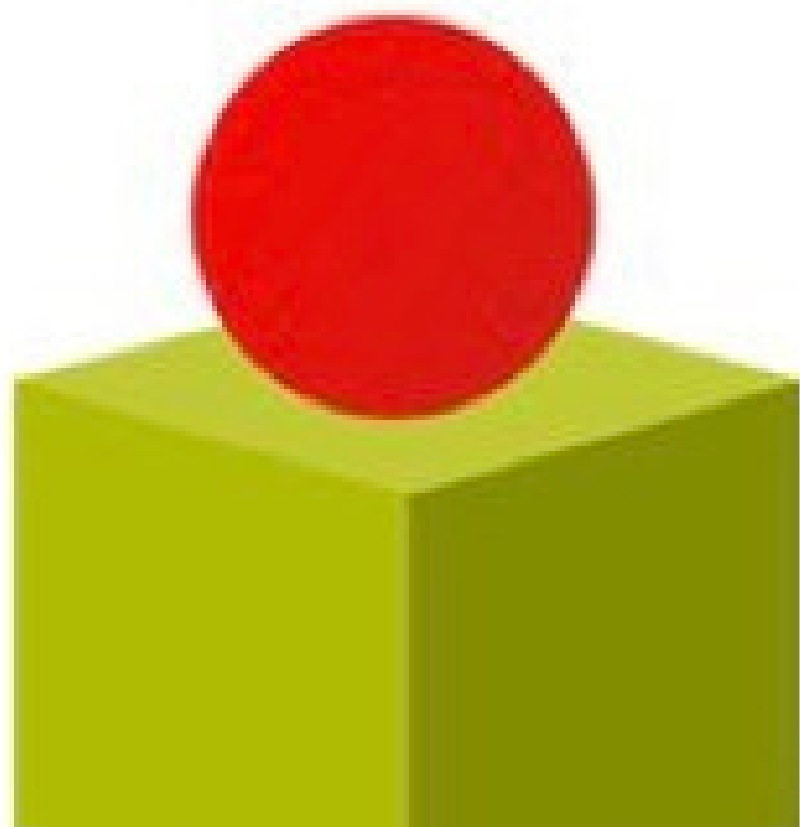
