Learning objectives: students should be able to use past tense correctly

>We use the past tense to describe an action that started and finished at a specific time in the past, for example:

I **saw** a movie yesterday.

She **watched** TV last night.

Last summer, my parents **visited** Australia.

We **had** lunch together two hours ago.

Did Suzan **play** tennis yesterday?

Keep these rules in mind when changing the regular basic form of a verb to the past tense.

1. Sometimes adding **ed** to a verb will change it to the past tense.

talk - talked blink - blinked look - looked

2. Verbs ending in **e** take only -d.

love - loved smile - smiled. bake - baked

3. Verb ending in a consonant + **y**, drop the **y** and take **-ied**

fry - fried cry - cried carry - carried

4. Verbs ending in a vowel + **y**, take **-ed**

stay - stayed play - played. pray - prayed

5. verb ending in one **stressed vowel** between two consonants double the

last consonant and take **ed** . (never double **w/y/x/or z**)

stop - stopped Plan- planned

There are some irregular verbs and there is no rule for these verbs .

should learn them by heart

In negative sentences and questions, we use did / didn't and the infinitive.

We don't use the past simple form of the verb.

- They **didn't come** with us.

~~- They didn't came with us.~~ wrong

- Did you **like** the film? V

~~- Did you liked the film?~~ wrong

The past simple of verb to be is was and were. -

I **was** at home at 8 o'clock.

He **wasn't** at the party last time.
