Relative Pronouns

***Relative pronouns :**

Relative Pronoun	Used For	Example
who	people	The girl who draws beautifully is my sister.
which	things / animals	The dog which is sitting under the tree is hungry.
that	people or things	The book that I bought is interesting.
where	places	The park where we play is new.
when	time	I remember the day when we met.
whose	possession	The boy whose bag is brown is my cousin.

***We use the relative pronouns to make relative clauses.**

***Relative clauses** are used to give more information about a noun (people, thing, place and animal). They start with relative pronouns

The man **who is wearing a black hat** is my father.

There are two types of relative clause:

1-Defining

Non-defining

Type	What It Does	Example	With Commas?
Defining	Gives essential (important) information. It defines <i>which</i> person or thing you mean.	The girl who is wearing a red dress is my sister.	? No commas
Non-defining	Gives extra information. It's not needed to understand who or what you mean.	My sister, who is wearing a red dress , is very helpful.	? Use commas
