## What is a pronoun?

A **pronoun** is a word that we use **instead of a noun** (a name of a person, place, or thing). We use pronouns to **avoid repeating** the same nouns again and again.

### Example:

- **Anna** is my friend. **She** is very kind.  
(We use **she** instead of saying "Anna" again.)

## Why do we use pronouns?

We use pronouns to:

- Make sentences **shorter**
- Make speaking and writing **easier**
- Avoid repeating names or nouns

## Types of Pronouns You Need to Know:

Type	Use	Example
Subject Pronouns	Do the action	I, you, he, she, it, we, they
Object Pronouns	Receive the action	me, you, him, her, it, us, them
Possessive Adjectives	Show who owns something (before a noun)	my, your, his, her, its, our, their
Possessive Pronouns	show ownership (replace the noun)	mine, yours, his, hers, ours, theirs
Reflexive Pronouns	Refer back to the subject	myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, yourselves, themselves

**\*\*What's the difference between *its* and *it's*?**

**1. IT'S = IT IS or IT HAS**

"It's" is a **contraction** (short form).

It combines:

- it is
- or it has

**Examples:**

- It's a sunny day. → (It **is** a sunny day.)
- It's been a long time. → (It **has** been a long time.)

## **2. ITS = Possessive adjective**

"Its" shows that **something belongs to "it."**

It is like **my, your, his, her** – but for things or animals.

◆ **Examples:**

- The cat is licking **its** paw. → (The paw of the cat)
- The company changed **its** logo.

**!Note:** "Its" does **not** have an apostrophe (').
