### What is a pronoun?

A **pronoun** is a word that we use **instead of a noun** (a name of a person, place, or thing). We use pronouns to **avoid repeating** the same nouns again and again.

### **Example:**

Anna is my friend. She is very kind.
 (We use she instead of saying "Anna" again.)

### Why do we use pronouns?

We use pronouns to:

- Make sentences **shorter**
- Make speaking and writing easier
- Avoid repeating names or nouns

#### **Types of Pronouns You Need to Know:**

Туре	Use	Example	
<b>Subject Pronouns</b>	Do the action	I, you, he, she, it, we, they	
<b>Object Pronouns</b>	Receive the action	me, you, him, her, it, us, them	
Possessive Adjectives	Show who owns something (before a noun)	my, your, his, her, its, our, their	
Possessive Pronouns	show ownership (replace the noun)	mine, yours, his, hers, ours, theirs	
Reflexive Pronouns	Refer back to the subject	myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, yourselves, themselves

### \*\*What's the difference between its and it's?

## 1. IT'S = IT IS or IT HAS

"It's" is a contraction (short form). It combines:

- it is
- or it has

### **Examples:**

- It's a sunny day. → (It is a sunny day.)
- It's been a long time. → (It has been a long time.)

### 2. ITS = Possessive adjective

"Its" shows that something belongs to "it."
It is like my, your, his, her – but for things or animals.

### **Examples:**

- The cat is licking **its** paw. → (The paw of the cat)
- The company changed its logo.

!Note: "Its" does not have an apostrophe (').
