Simple Present

Q What is the Simple Present Tense?

We use the **simple present tense** to talk about:

- Things we do regularly (habits)
- Facts or general truths

≪ Examples:

- I play football.
- She eats breakfast at 7 a.m.
- They like cartoons.

1. Forming the Verb (Adding -s/-es/-ies)

Subject	Verb Form	Example
I / You / We / They	Base verb	I walk to school.
He / She / It	Add -s/-es/-ies	He walks to school.

* Rules for adding 's', 'es', or 'ies':				
1. Just a	add -s:			
0	play → plays			
0	read → reads			
2. Add -	es when verb ends in: -ch, -sh, -s, -x, or -o:			
0	watch o watches			
0	go → goes			
0	$fix \rightarrow fixes$			
3. Chan	ge -y to -ies (if a consonant comes before the 'y'):			
0	study → studies			
0	carry → carries			
4. Keep -y if a vowel comes before it:				
0	play → plays			
0	enjoy → enjoys

Use do not	(don't) or does not (doesn't):			
• I do r	not (don't) like fish.			
• He d o	pes not (doesn't) eat vegetables.			

Use base verb after don't/doesn't:

They **don't want** to visit their friends.

✓ He doesn't eat.
