**Adverbs of manner** tell us how the action takes place. Most adverbs of manner are formed by adding -ly to the adjective.

**An adverb usually comes after the verb or after the object in a sentence.**

## Examples:

- We ate lunch **quickly**. How did we eat lunch? quickly (quick + -ly)
- They spoke **softly**. How did they speak? softly (soft+ -ly)
- She smiled **gladly**, How did she smile? gladly (glad +-ly)
- He speaks English **fluently**. How does he speak English? (fluent +-ly)



Some adverbs are **irregular**. For example, “**good**” changes to “**well**.”

**Examples:** They played **well**.



Some adverbs stay the same as the adjective. For example: fast → fast

## Examples:

She runs **fast**.

My father works **hard**.

They arrived **late**.

The boy wakes up **early**
