**Adverbs of manner** tell us how the action takes place. Most adverbs of manner are formed by adding -ly to the adjective.

An adverb usually comes after the verb or after the object in a sentence.

#### **Examples:**

- We ate lunch quickly. How did we eat lunch? quickly (quick + -ly)
- They spoke **softly**. How did they speak? softly (soft+ -ly)
- She smiled **gladly**, How did she smile? gladly (glad +-ly)
- He speaks English **fluently**. How does he speak English? (fluent +-ly)



Some adverbs are irregular. For example, "good" changes to "well."

Examples: They played well.



Some adverbs stay the same as the adjective. For example: fast  $\rightarrow$  fast

#### **Examples**:

She runs fast.

My father works hard.

They arrived late.

The boy wakes up early
