- Use of Simple Past Tense:-

1. To describe an action which started and finished in the past at a specific point of time .

He bought a new house **last month**.

Simple past formation

Affirmative Form :-

Subject + Verb 2 + Complement .

*** I watched a nice movie last night.(Regular verb)**

*** She came early yesterday .(Irregular verb)**

Negative Form :-

Subject + didn't + Verb 1 + Complement.

*** I didn't call her yesterday.**

*** He didn't miss the class last week.**

Question Form:-

(Did) + Subject + Inf.v + Complement ?

Did you call me yesterday?

Simple Past Tense
Regular Verbs

Spelling Rules	Examples
Ending in e add d	live – lived stare – stared
Ending in vowel + y add ed	stay – stayed play – played
Ending in consonant + y change y to i and add ed	try – tried carry – carried
One syllable, single vowel and ending in single consonant double the final consonant and add ed	nod – nodded rip – ripped
Two-syllable, stress on second syllable and ending in single consonant double the final consonant and add ed	commit – committed prefer – preferred
