#### **ACTIVE VOCABULARY** — Partitives

What are Partitives?

Partitives are expressions we use to talk about a part or quantity of something that cannot be easily counted (uncountable nouns).

They help us describe how much or what portion of something we mean.

For example, we don't say "an advice" or "a fruit" — we say "a piece of advice" or "a piece of fruit."

So, a partitive is usually made up of two parts: a word showing the quantity or part (like *piece*, *drop*, *slice*) the uncountable noun (like *advice*, *oil*, *bread*)

Together, they make a natural English expression.

## Examples and Meanings
