8. **dessert (n)** sweet food served as the last course of a meal

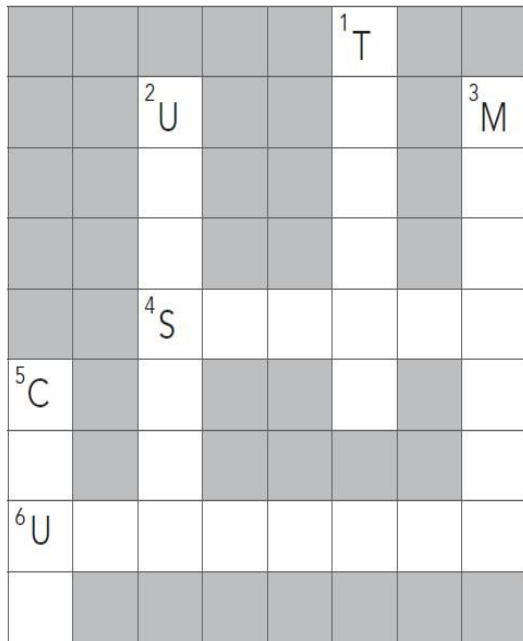
9. **home-made (adj)** made at home, not bought from a shop
