# Stative Verbs

## Definition

Stative verbs are words that describe states of being, feelings, or conditions, rather than actions.

## Sentences

- She hates rainy days.
- They believe in ghosts.
- She feels tired.
- He seems tired today.
- She dislike spicy food.
- I love chocolate cake.

~~Bread is consisting of flour, water and yeast.~~

**2. Emotion:** Love Like Dislike Hate Adore Prefer Care for Mind  
Want Need Desire Wish Hope Appreciate Value

Example: Julie's always hated dogs.

~~Julie's always been hating dogs.~~

**3. Sense:** Sound Hear Smell See Taste Touch Feel Look

Example: Do you hear music?

~~Are you hearing music?~~

**4. Mental state:** Know Believe Understand Doubt Suppose Recognise Forget Remember  
Imagine Mean Agree Disagree Deny Promise Satisfy Realise  
Appear Astonish Please Surprise Concern Think (have an opinion)

Example: I know this story.

~~I am knowing this story.~~
