Tenses...Unit Two...

1. Simple Past...

We use it to talk about:

a. things that started and finished in the past.

He visited his aunt yesterday.

b. things that happened one after the other in the past.

He got dressed, went downstairs and had breakfast.

c. things that happened often or were habits in the past.

They played hockey when they were at school.

d. past states..

I was exhausted after the show.



The Form...

He - She - It

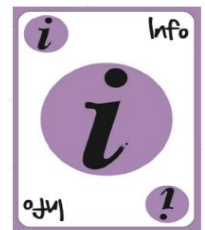
They



Verb + (d - ed - ied) or Irregular verb.

I - We - You

(speak - spoke)



Negative : Sub + didn't + verb (inf.)+com.

Inter: Did + Sub + Verb (inf.)+ com?

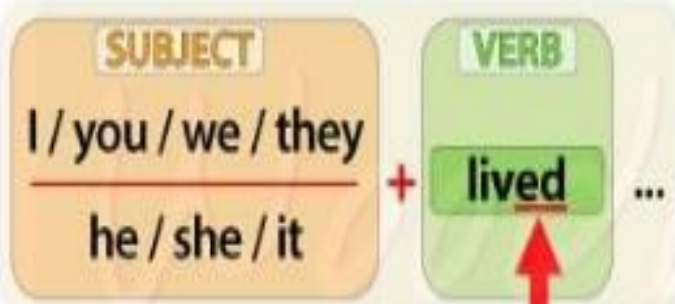
Time Expressions with the Simple Past...

last - week , month, year, summer , night a week ago - a month ago.

Yesterday - the day before yesterday- in 1998 - on Sunday.

When I was five years old - In December- on 30th June.

+ Affirmative



Past tense regular verbs end in -ed.

- + Affirmative: I **lived** in London.
- + Affirmative: She **lived** in Paris.
- + Affirmative: He **watched** a movie.
- + Affirmative: They **wanted** a holiday.

There is only one form of each verb in the past simple tense.*

* The exception is TO BE which has two forms: was and were.

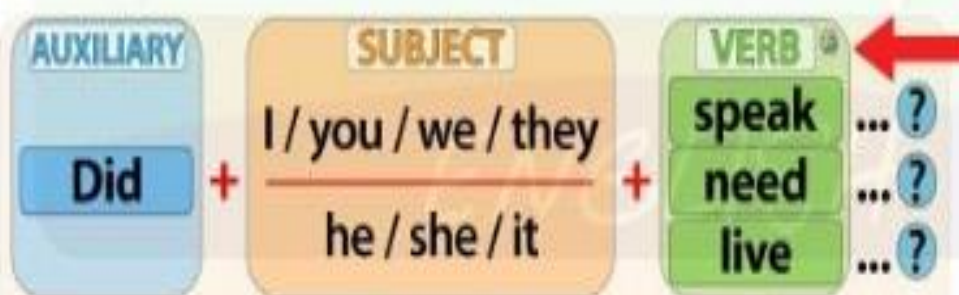
- Negative



- + Affirmative: I **lived** in Spain.
- Negative: I **didn't** **live** in Spain.

- + Affirmative: He **watched** a movie.
- Negative: He **didn't** **watch** a movie.

? Question



- + Affirmative: You **lived** in Italy.
- ? Question: **Did** you **live** in Italy?

- + Affirmative: She **watched** a movie.
- ? Question: **Did** she **watch** a movie?

2. Past Continuous...

We use it to talk about:

a. actions that were in progress at a particular time in the past.

I was writing a letter at five o'clock in the morning.

b. two or more actions that were in progress at the same time in the past.

Mum was making lunch and Dad was gardening.

He was washing the car and listening to the radio.

c. for setting the scene of a story.

The sun was shining and the birds were singing in the trees.

The wind was blowing and it was raining.

The Form...

He - She - It - I → was + verb- ing + com.

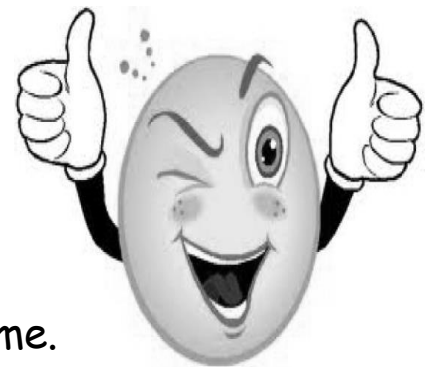
They- We - You → were + verb - ing + com.

Negative : Sub + **wasn't** + verb (ing) + com.

Sub + **weren't** + verb (ing) + com.

Inter: Was + Sub + Verb (ing) + com?

Were + Sub + Verb (ing) + com?



Time Expressions with the Past Continuous...

1. When:

When I got home, my friends were waiting for me.

She was eating her dinner when I arrived.

2. While:

While I was working, mum was making lunch.

It was raining while I was sleeping

While he was driving along the road, a dog ran in front of his car.

3. as - at ten o'clock last night.

Past continuous Tense



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It is used to talk about actions or events that were happening at a specific time in the past. It is formed by combining "was" or "were" with the base form of the verb and adding "ing."



Time Words

At 5 PM
yesterday

While I was at
work

When the phone
rang



Structure

Sub + was/were (sing/plur) + V₁+ ing

Examples

- She was cooking dinner.
- They were watching a movie.
- I was studying for the test.
- He was playing the guitar.
- The kids were playing in the garden.



Structure

Sub + wasn't/weren't (sing/plur) + V₁+ ing

Examples

- She was not cooking dinner.
- They were not watching a movie.
- I was not studying for the test.
- He was not playing the guitar.
- It was not raining heavily.



Structure

was/were (sing/plur) + sub+ V₁+ -ing + ?

Examples

- Was she cooking dinner?
- Were they watching a movie?
- Was I studying for the test?
- Was he playing the guitar?
- Were the kids playing in the garden?
