Possessive Adjectives

Possessive adjectives are words that show who **owns** something. They are used before nouns to show that something belongs to someone.

Here are the possessive adjectives:


- My shows that something belongs to me.
- Your shows that something belongs to you.
- **His** shows that something belongs to *him*.
- Her shows that something belongs to her.
- Its shows that something belongs to it (used for animals or things).
- Our shows that something belongs to us.
- **Their** shows that something belongs to *them*.

Example Sentences:

- This is my book.
- That is your pencil.
- **His** dog is very cute.
- Her shoes are new.
- The cat is licking its paws.
- Our house is big.
- Their car is red.
