## Possessive Adjectives

Possessive adjectives are words that show who **owns** something. They are used before nouns to show that something belongs to someone.

Here are the possessive adjectives:

- **My** – shows that something belongs to *me*.
- **Your** – shows that something belongs to *you*.
- **His** – shows that something belongs to *him*.
- **Her** – shows that something belongs to *her*.
- **Its** – shows that something belongs to *it* (used for animals or things).
- **Our** – shows that something belongs to *us*.
- **Their** – shows that something belongs to *them*.

### Example Sentences:

- This is **my** book.
- That is **your** pencil.
- **His** dog is very cute.
- **Her** shoes are new.
- The cat is licking **its** paws.
- **Our** house is big.
- **Their** car is red.

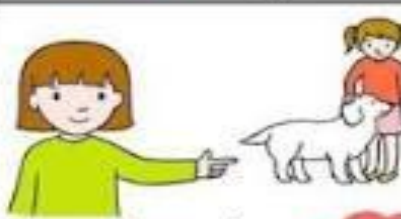
