- "The Tyger" – William Blake
- "The Wind" – Christina Rossetti

Presentation Instructions

Each student must prepare one poster OR a PowerPoint about the chosen poem. The presentation should include:

- Explain the poem in your own words.
- Describe the poem's message and how it makes you feel.
- Find and list figurative language and sound devices (simile, metaphor, personification, onomatopoeia, alliteration, rhyme, repetition).
- Explain the figurative language you chose.

- Choose your favourite line and explain why you like it.

How to Present in Class

- **Speak in a loud, clear voice.**
- **Do not read from the paper.**
- Make eye contact with the audience.
- Show confidence.
- Follow all presentation notes previously taught.

Separate Poster – Write Your Own Poem

- Your poem must be 5 lines or more.
- Choose any topic you love.
- Include at least one figurative language device.
- Write it neatly and decorate the poster for the Class Poetry Wall.
