Word / Phrase	Arabic Meaning	Synonym(s)	Example Sentence (from lesson)
bring (something) home to someone	يوضح بوضوح / يجعلني أدرك بشدة	make clear, emphasize	The programme on nutrition really brought home to me how dangerous some foods are.
haul someone over the coals	يؤنخ بشدة	scold, reprimand	I got hauled over the coals a lot as a child for sneaking chocolate bars.
slurp	يشرب بصوت مزعج	sip noisily	I hate hearing someone slurp their drink – it is so rude!
sinking feeling	شعور بالقلق / إحساس سيئ	bad feeling, anxiety	I've got a sinking feeling that the bill will be astronomical.
become a thing of the past	أصبح من الماضي	disappear, vanish	Asking permission to leave the table has become a thing of the past .
mind my manners	أكون مهذباً / أراعي أدابي	behave well	My mum used to tell me to mind my manners at friends' houses.

documentary	وثائقي	factual film	Zeina was surprised by a documentary about modern manners.
toe-curling	مخرج جداً	embarrassing	She uses the word toe-curling to describe the children's behaviour.
nightmare	شيء فظيع	terrible situation	The behaviour in the restaurant was a nightmare .
indefensible	غير مبرر	unjustifiable	She describes throwing food as indefensible .
respect	احترام	consideration	Good table manners show respect for others.
