Presentation Instructions

- Explain the poem in your own words.
- Describe the poem’s message and how it makes you feel.
- Identify the figurative language and sound devices (simile, metaphor, personification, onomatopoeia, alliteration, rhyme, repetition).
- Explain how the figurative language adds meaning.
- Choose your favourite lines and explain why you like them.

How to Present in Class

- Speak in a loud, clear voice.
- Do not read from the paper.
- Make eye contact with the audience.
- Show confidence.
- Follow all presentation steps taught in class.

- **Your poem must be 8–12 lines.**
- **Choose any topic you love.**
- **Include at least two figurative language devices.**
- **Write neatly and decorate the poster for the Class Poetry Wall.**
