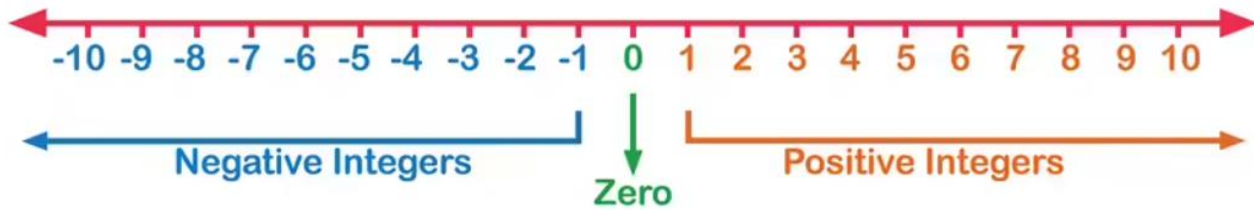


Positive and Negative Numbers Summary



1. Zero is greater than all negative numbers and less than all positive numbers.
2. For positive numbers, the greater number is the number that is farthest from zero.
3. For negative numbers, the greater number is the number that is closest to zero.
4. All positive numbers are greater than negative numbers.
5. Use a number line to compare values visually (optional).
6. An **integer** is a whole number that can be positive, negative, or zero.
