
Positive and Negative Numbers Summary



- 1. Zero is greater than all negative numbers and less than all positive numbers.
- 2. For positive numbers, the greater number is the number that is farthest from zero.
- 3. For negative numbers, the greater number is the number that is closest to zero.
- 4. All positive numbers are greater than negative numbers.
- 5. Use a number line to compare values visually (optional).
- 6. An **integer** is a whole number that can be positive, negative, or zero.
