Past simple and Past continuous

 We often use the past simple and the past continuous together. The past simple describes a short action that interrupts a longer past continuous action in progress.

The word when goes at the beginning of the simple past clause.
 Past continuous
 They were walking to school when they saw a cat in a tree.

 Past simple work up
 When I woke up,
 Past continuous my brother was singing in the kitchen.

In negative sentences and questions, we use did / didn't and the infinitive.

We don't use the past simple form of the verb.

- They didn't come with us.

They didn't came with us. wrong

- Did you like the film? V

- Did you liked the film? wrong

The past simple of verb to be is was and were. -

I was at home at 8 o'clock.

He wasn't at the party last time.
