- Lesson 2: Past Simple Irregular Verbs
- 1. What are irregular verbs?
  - Some verbs do NOT add -ed in the past. Example:  $eat \rightarrow ate$ , not eated.
- 2. Same form for all subjects

Irregular verbs do not change with he, she, they, we, or I.

- √ I ate
- √ She ate
- √ They ate

All the same!

# 3. Negative form

To make a negative, we use:

didn't + base form (present form)

X I didn't bought.

✓ I didn't buy the book.

4. Questions

To make questions, we use:

Did + subject + base form

✓ Did you put the book on the shelf? (We do NOT say Did you putted.)

Lesson 4: Past Simple - Wh- Questions

Wh- words: What, Where, When, Why, Who, How

1. With normal verbs (regular & irregular)

Use:

Wh- word + did + subject + base form

- What did you eat on Saturday?
- · Where did they play basketball?

#### Remember:

After did, the verb returns to the base form (eat—not ate, play—not played).

2. With the verb be (was / were)

When the verb is was / were, we do NOT use did.

Use:

Wh- word + was/were + subject

- · When was the party?
- · Why were you late?

### √ Summary (Very Easy)

Туре	Rule	Example
Irregular verb past	Verb changes (not -ed)	eat $ ightarrow$ ate
Negative	didn't + base form	I didn't eat
Question	Did + subject + base form	Did he eat?
Wh- question with verbs	Wh-word + did + base	What did you eat?
Wh- question with be	Wh-word + was/were	Why were you late?

### Past Simple: Irregular Verbs & Wh- Questions

#### Explanation

- 1. Irregular verbs do not take -ed in the past (eat  $\rightarrow$  ate, go  $\rightarrow$  went).
- 2. The past form is the same for all subjects (I ate, she ate, they ate).
- 3. Negative form: didn't + base form (I didn't eat).
- 4. Questions: Did + subject + base form (Did you eat?).
- 5. Wh- questions with verbs: Wh-word + did + subject + base form (What did you eat?).
- 6. Wh- questions with the verb be: Wh-word + was/were + subject (Why were you late?).
