A / AN + singular countable nouns

A + CONSONANT SOUND There is a bottle on the table.

AN + <u>vower sound</u> There is an apple on the table.

SOME / ANY + plural countable nouns & uncountable nouns

+ affirmative SOME There is some cheese in the fridge.

negative ANY There isn't any cheese in the fridge.



Use *a/an, some, any* and *lots of* to say how much of something there is. Nouns can be divided into countable (a banana, six eggs) or uncountable (some ice cream, some salad).

	Countable nouns	Uncountable nouns
Affirmative sentences	There's <b>a banana</b> .  There are <b>some eggs</b> .  There are <b>lots of apples</b> .	There's <b>some salad</b> . There's <b>lots of ice cream</b> .
Negative sentences	There aren't <b>any grapes</b> .	There isn't <b>any lemonade</b> .
Questions	Are there <b>any kiwis</b> ?	Is there <b>any bread</b> ?

Note: Use some in affirmative sentences. Use any in negative sentences and questions.
