The role of management

- **❖** The role and functions of management:
 - 1- Planning: which means setting aims and targets
 - 2- Organizing: organize people and resources very carefully.
 - 3- <u>Coordinating</u>: make sure that all departments work together to achieve the plans.
 - 4- <u>Commanding</u>: instructions and commands must be provided to make sure that the tasks are done.
 - 5- Controlling: try to measure and evaluate the work of all workers to make sure that they are on target.
- It's important to have good managers but not all managers are leaders.
- **!** Leadership is to inspire and get the best out of the workforce.
- **Styles of leadership:**
 - 1- Autocratic leadership
 - 2- Democratic leadership
 - 3- Laissez-faire leadership

Leadership styles	Definition	Advantage	Disadvantage
Autocratic leadership	A leadership style where the leader makes all decisions	Quick decision making	No opportunity for employee input in making decision which could be demotivating
Democratic leadership	A leadership style where employees take part in decision making	Better decision as new ideas	Rising up of mistakes
Laissez-faire leadership	A leadership style where most of the decisions are left to the employee	Encourage employees to show creativity and responsibility	Unlikely to be appropriate for customer service
