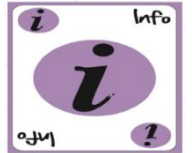

1- Question Tags...



1. A tag question is a short question (e.g. **have you?** / **haven't you?**) that follows a statement:

You haven't got a car, **have you?**

It was a good film, **wasn't it?**

2. Normally we use a positive question tag with a negative sentence:

Negative sentence + positive tag

Tom **won't** be late, **will he?**

They **don't** like us, **do they?**

That **isn't** George over there, **is it?**

And normally we use a negative question tag with a positive sentence:

Positive sentence + Negative tag

Ann **will** be here soon, **won't she?**

Tom **should** pass his exam, **shouldn't he?**

They **were** very angry, **weren't they?**

3. How do we form QUESTION TAGS?

a) Auxiliaries like **be, have, can, may, must, should**, etc. used in the statement are reported at the end followed by the subject (always a pronoun):

John was annoyed, **wasn't he?**

He **wasn't** annoyed, **was he?**

Note ...

1. I **am** late, **aren't** I? Notice that we say **aren't I?** (= am I not)
2. **Let's** play tennis, **shall** we?
3. **Everyone** is excited, **aren't** they?
4. **Don't touch** the statues in the museum, **will** you?
5. **Be** careful, **won't** you?
6. **This/That** is so dangerous, **isn't** it?
7. **These/ Those** are wonderful paintings, **aren't** they?

2- ECHO QUESTIONS

- To request further information, seek information, to express interest, concern, anger, surprise, disbelief, suspicion or to show that we are listening.

E.g. Past Simple: A: I **bought** a cheap book (+)

B: **Did** you? (+)

E.g. Present Simple: A: She **reads** the newspaper every day (+)

B: **Does** she? (+)

E.g. Present Perfect: A: I **haven't** taken the exam yet. (-)

B: **Haven't** you? (-)

E.g. Modal verbs: A: He **couldn't** have done it (-)

B: **Couldn't** he? (-)
