Learning objective: Student's should be able to be familiar when to use the prepositions.

Prepositions of Time - at, in, on

We use at:

1- Times of day.

Ex: We go to sleep at ten o'clock.

2- The following expressions:

At the weekend - at the moment - at night - at Christmas.

We use in:

1- Months, years , seasons , decades (100 years)

In July - in 2010 - in summer - in the 1880s

2- The following expressions.

In the morning/evening/afternoon

3- A period of time.

In 40 minutes - in two hours - in 10 seconds

We use on:

1- Days and dates:

On Tuesday - on Tuesday morning - on 23rd/Oct

Prepositions of place

We use at:

- 1- Relative prepositions.
At the front - at the top - at the back - at the end
- 2- A specific place or point.
At the table - at the corner - at the office - at my friend's house.

We use in:

- 1- Enclosed spaces.
In my bag - in the kitchen - in hospital - in the park
- 2- Countries and cities.
In England - in Madaba - in London
- 3- Water.
In the sea - in the river - in the pond
- 4- Other things that contain something.
In his book - in the text - in the picture - in the queue

We use on:

- 1- Surfaces:
On the floor - on the wall - on the ceiling
- 2- Transport:
On a plane - on a bus - on a ship/boat
- 3- Floors :
On the ground - on the first/second floor
Note: we say in the basement / attic
- 4- Parts of an object:
On the front of the blouse - on the back of his hand
- 5- Left / right
On the right of the school - on the left of the restaurant

Look at these examples:

- Jane is waiting for you **at** the bus stop.
- The shop is **at** the end of the street.
- My plane stopped **at** Dubai and Hanoi and arrived **in** Bangkok two hours late.
- When will you arrive **at** the office?
- Do you work **in** an office?
- I have a meeting **in** New York.
- Do you live **in** Japan?
- Jupiter is **in** the Solar System.
- The author's name is **on** the cover of the book.
- There are no prices **on** this menu.
- You are standing **on** my foot.
- There was a "no smoking" sign **on** the wall.
- I live **on** the 7th floor **at** 21 Oxford Street **in** London.

Prepositions of directions....

1- We use to....

To express movement from one place to another.

I go to school.

2- We use from...

To express where something started.

He came home from school early.

3- We use into ...

To show that something has entered a place.

The teacher came into the class.

4- We use onto ...

To show that something has moved to a position on something.

The cat jumped onto the wall.

5- We use towards ...

To show that something is moving in a particular direction.

The dog ran towards the cat.

He sleeps in the middle of the day.

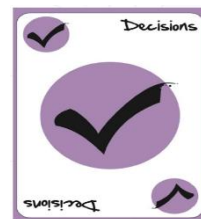
They are tired at the end of the week.
