\* The base form of the infinitive = ~~to~~ go, ~~to~~ need, ~~to~~ speak, ~~to~~ live  
Did tells us it is a question in the past simple tense.

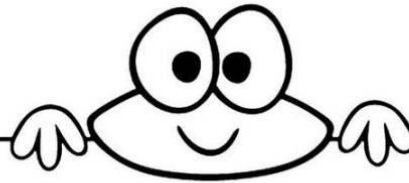

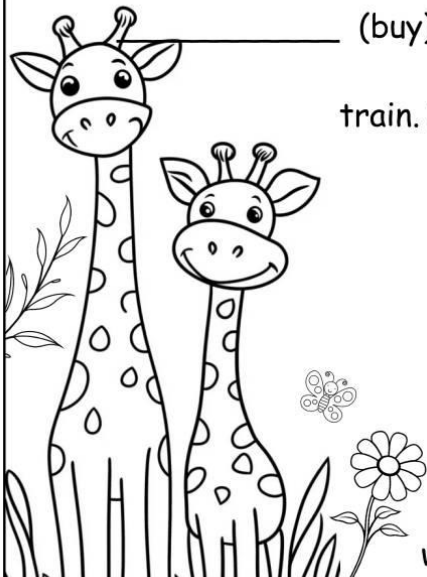
## Past Tense
