



Adverbs of Frequency

We use adverbs of frequency to say how often we do the action. We usually put the adverb **before** the verb.



Never means no times.

Examples:

She **always** practices the piano in the evenings. **Every day!**

We $\not\subset$ usually \supset go to the park on Sundays. Most Sundays!

They sometimes make a cake. Just for special days!

He (never) forgets his homework. No times!
