A. Photography & Description Vocabulary

Word / Phrase	Arabic Meaning	Explanation	Example from Lesson
Shot	لقطة (صورة)	A single photograph taken by a camera.	<i>The shot looks like he is moving forward...</i>
Cropped	مقصوفة / مقطوعة	When a part of the image is cut off to improve the view.	<i>... but is not cropped very well because the background is actually a photo.</i>
Background	الخلفية	The part of the picture that is behind the main subject.	<i>... because the background is actually a photo.</i>
Captures	يلتقط / يعكس	Shows something very clearly.	<i>The image really captures the close relationship...</i>
Close relationship	علاقة وثيقة	A strong connection between people or animals.	<i>... the close relationship she developed with animals...</i>
Likeness	شبهه / ملامح مشابهة	A similarity between two things or people.	<i>It also shows a likeness between people and chimpanzees.</i>
Natural (pose)	طبيعي (غير مصطنع)	When someone looks relaxed, not trying to pose.	<i>They look very natural, not as if they were posing.</i>
Poignant	مؤثر / يلامس المشاعر	Something that causes strong emotion, often sadness.	<i>This poignant photo is carefully composed...</i>
Composed	مُرْتَب / مُنظَّم	Carefully arranged by the photographer.	<i>... this poignant photo is carefully composed.</i>
Iconic	أيقوني / شهير جدًا	Very famous and representative of a moment in history.	<i>The photographer knew immediately that the photo would become iconic.</i>
Propaganda	دعاية سياسية إيجابية أو سلبية	Images or messages used to influence people's opinions.	<i>The photo was taken as a kind of positive propaganda.</i>
Subject matter	موضوع الصورة	What the photo is mainly about.	<i>Who or what is the subject matter of the photo?</i>

Picture Descriptions (A–D)

Description	Meaning	Example from Lesson
1	The man looks like he's moving, but the image was poorly edited because the background is fake.	<i>The shot looks like he is moving forward... background is actually a photo.</i>
2	Shows her strong bond with animals and the similarity between chimps and humans.	<i>The image really captures the close relationship...</i>
3	A natural lunch-break moment with the workers, not posed.	<i>They look very natural, not as if they were posing.</i>
4	A sad, well-composed image of a man who seems to be standing alone.	<i>This poignant photo is carefully composed...</i>
