


Past Simple Irregular Verbs

Explanation

The Past Simple tense is used to talk about actions that happened and were completed in the past.

- 1. Regular verbs form the past tense by adding '-ed' (e.g., 'walk' ----> 'walked').
- 2. Irregular verbs, however, do not follow this pattern and have unique past forms. Below are some common irregular verbs:
