


### Past Simple Irregular Verbs

#### Explanation

The Past Simple tense is used to **talk about actions that happened and were completed in the past.**

1. **Regular verbs** form the past tense by adding '-ed'  
(e.g., 'walk' ----> 'walked').
2. Irregular verbs, however, do not follow this pattern and have unique past forms.  
Below are some common irregular verbs:



Present	Past
1. Be	was / were
2. Eat	ate
3. Have	had
4. See	saw
5. Give	gave
6. Make	made
7. Put	put
8. Throw	threw
9. Wear	wore
