Objective: Students will be able to form and answer WH- questions in the past simple tense.

WH- Questions in the Past Simple

We use WH- questions to ask for more information about something that happened in the past.

The structure is:

WH-word + did + subject + base verb?

Example: Where did you go yesterday?

1. WHERE

Meaning: asks about a place.

Use: to ask where something happened.

Examples:

- Where did you go yesterday?
- Where did she put her bag?

2. WHY

Meaning: asks about a reason.

Use: to ask why something happened.

Examples:

- · Why did he cry?
- · Why did they leave early?

3. WHEN

Meaning: asks about time.

Use: to ask when something happened.

Examples:

· When did you wake up?

When did the movie start?

4. WHAT

Meaning: asks about things or actions.

Use: to ask what someone did.

Examples:

· What did you eat for lunch?

· What did she buy?

WH-Questions with Be in the Past Simple

We use was and were to talk about the past.

We make WH-questions to ask for more information about people, places, time, things, or reasons.

Structure:

WH-word + was/were + subject?

Examples:

• Where was the dog?
Where was the teacher?

• Why were they late? Why was he upset?

• When was the party? When were you at school?

• What was your homework? What were the answers?
