Present Simple: Negative form

**\*Learning Objective:** Students should be able to turn the affirmative sentences into negative using **do not** + **does not**.

**Pronouns** (I, you, we and they) took **do not**.

**Pronouns** (He, she and it) took **does not**.

**Examples:**

**Affirmative form:** I **like** basketball.

**Negative form:** I **do not like** basketball.

**Affirmative form:** Jim and Sam **play** football on Sundays.

**Negative form:** Jim and Sam **do not play** football on Sundays.

**Affirmative form:** Sia **brushes** her teeth every day.

**Negative form:** Sia **does not brush** her teeth every day.

**Affirmative form:** Leo **eats** his dinner every day.

**Negative form:** Leo **does not eat** his dinner every day.

**Affirmative form:** The cat **climbs** up a tree.

**Negative form:** The cat **does not climb** up a tree.

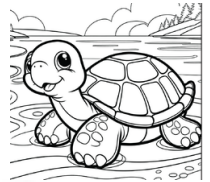
