Pronouns (I, you, we and they) took **do not**.

Pronouns (He, she and it) took does not.

Examples:

Affirmative form: I like basketball.

Negative form: I do not like basketball.

Affirmative form: Jim and Sam **play** football on Sundays.

Negative form: Jim and Sam do not play football on Sundays.

Affirmative form: Sia brushes her teeth every day.

Negative form: Sia does not brush her teeth every day.

Affirmative form: Leo eats his dinner every day.

Negative form: Leo does not eat his dinner every day.

Affirmative form: The cat climbs up a tree.

Negative form: The cat does not climb up a tree.


