



Have got with plural nouns
and pronouns (they/ you/
we/I)

Has got with singular nouns
and pronouns (he/ she)

Examples:

- 1- We have got big house.
- 2- They have got small chairs.
- 3- She has got a balcony.
- 4- He has got a nice living room.

Possessive adjectives

This is **our** table. That's **their** table.

my	her
your	our
his	their

We use the possessive adjective to say that something belongs to someone.

We take the possessive adjective from the subject pronoun


Subject pronoun	Possessive adjective
He→	His
She→	Her
It→	My
They→	Their
We→	Our
You→	Your

Example :

- 1- This is my book.
- 2- That is their house.
- 3- These are her books.
- 4- Those are your pens.
