Definition

Stative verbs are words that describe states of being, feelings, or conditions, rather than actions.

Sentences

- She hates rainy days.
- They believe in ghosts.
- She feels tired.
- He seems tired today.
- She dislike spicy food.
- I love chocolate cake.
