



Vocabulary Past Paper 2017

Read the meaning of each word carefully. Then study the example sentences.

1. Gave – Put – Won

Gave

Meaning: To hand something to someone.

Example: She gave her friend a gift.

Put

Meaning: To place something somewhere.

Example: He put his bag on the table.

Won

Meaning: To be the best in a game or competition.

Example: Our team won the football match.

2. Add – Keep – Include

Add

Meaning: To put more to something.

Example: Please add sugar to my tea.

Keep

Meaning: To continue having or holding something.

Example: She keeps her books in her bag.

Include

Meaning: To make something part of a group.

Example: The trip will include lunch and games.

3. Sent – Arrived – Brought

Sent

Meaning: To make something go to a place.

Example: I sent an email to my teacher.

Arrived

Meaning: To reach a place.

Example: We arrived at school early.

Brought

Meaning: To carry something with you to a place.

Example: He brought his lunch from home.

4. Get – Turn – Take

Get

Meaning: To receive or obtain something.

Example: She got a present on her birthday.

Turn

Meaning: To change direction or change something.

Example: Please turn left at the corner.

Take

Meaning: To carry something or use time.

Example: He took his phone from the table.

5. Already – Then – Later

Already

Meaning: Something happened before now.

Example: I have already finished my homework.

Then

Meaning: After that (next).

Example: We ate dinner and then watched TV.

Later

Meaning: After some time.

Example: I will call you later.

6. Lose – Miss – Fail

Lose

Meaning: To not win or not have something anymore.

Example: I don't want to lose my keys.

Miss

Meaning: To not catch or not be present.

Example: She missed the bus this morning.

Fail

Meaning: To not succeed.

Example: He failed the test because he didn't study.
