

2. **Host:** (N) A person who presents or leads a show, event, or gathering
3. **Influencer:** (N) A person who has the power to affect the purchasing decisions or opinions of others, typically through social media.
4. **E-books** (N) Digital versions of printed books that can be read on electronic devices.
5. **Check out:** (Phrasal verb) To examine or look at something; also, to purchase items at a store or website.
6. **Constantly** (Adverb) Continuously, without interruption.
7. **Partly** (Adverb) To some extent; not completely.
8. **Promote:** (V) To support or actively encourage a cause, idea, or product.
9. **On purpose** (Phrase) Intentionally; done with deliberate intention.
10. **Destination** (N) The place to which someone or something is going or being sent.
11. **Popularity** (N) The state of being liked, admired, or supported by many people.
12. **Opportunities** (N) A set of circumstances that makes it possible to do something.
13. **Issues** (N) Problems, concerns, or subjects for discussion or debate.


14. **Worthy:** ( Adj) Having value, merit, or importance.

19. **Accommodation**(N) A place where someone may stay, such as a hotel or rented room; adjustments made to fit someone's needs.

21. **Troll** (N) A person who deliberately posts inflammatory or offensive comments online to provoke reactions
22. **Deny:**(V)To refuse to accept, acknowledge, or grant something.
